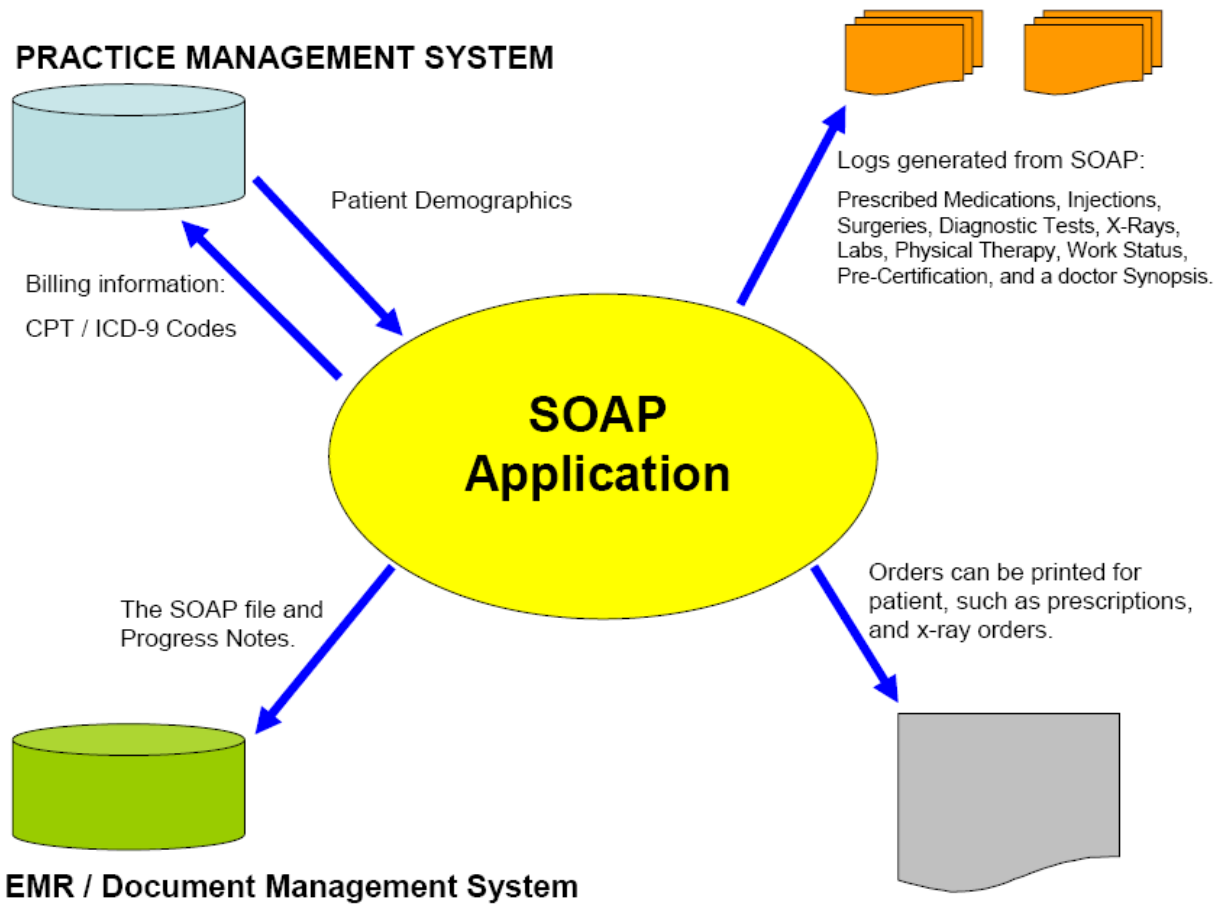


SOAP Application

An application designed by Orthopedic doctors FOR Orthopedic doctors.



SOAP refers to a particular format of recording information regarding treatment procedures during a patient visit. This documentation is an extremely important part of the treatment process. In virtually all medical settings, some form of documentation is required and SOAP notes are the most popular format in medical.

With EMR/EHR in mind, doctors need to be able to electronically capture patient visits. With this proven, easy to use application, there is no need to dictate, greatly reduce transcription, and start the billing process immediately.

- Doctors simply point and click as they see a patient (ease of use).
- Capture lost or unaccounted charges.
- Provide a more thorough examination and documentation.
- Create medical logs on the fly.
- Charts are available from anywhere at anytime.

Subjective	<p>General</p> <p>Chief Complaint</p> <p>Review of Systems</p>	<p>SUBJECTIVE:</p> <p>This section of the notation should describe the clinician's impressions of the client/patient. This section should be utilized to report subjective information of clinical significance gathered from the patient.</p>
Objective	<p>General</p> <p>Observation</p>	<p>OBJECTIVE (Common tests and Site specific tests):</p> <p>This section of the note will report the measurable and observable information obtained during the treatment session. Common tests and site specific tests are used to gather the objective information.</p>
Assessment	<p>Diagnosis</p> <p>X-Rays</p> <p>Diagnostic Studies</p> <p>PreOp Labs</p> <p>Plain Labs</p>	<p>ASSESSMENT (Diagnose, Order X-rays, Diagnostic Studies, and Labs):</p> <p>This section of the note will report the clinician's assessments, in descriptive terms, of the patient's performance during the session and/or the session itself. The section is where the diagnosis is determined and orders are initiated (such things as x-rays, MRI's, and labs).</p>
Plan	<p>Prescription</p> <p>Physical Therapy</p> <p>Surgery</p> <p>WorkStatus</p> <p>Casting</p> <p>Injection</p> <p>Supplies</p> <p>Ortho DME</p> <p>Treatments</p> <p>WoundCare</p> <p>Super Bill</p> <p>Dictation</p>	<p>PLAN (Order surgery, Therapy, Medications, etc.)</p> <p>After considering the information you gathered during the session, the final section of the SOAP note details the course of treatment, Here a doctor can prescribe medicine, physical therapy, order surgery, injections, supplies, etc.</p> <p>Also note that if the doctor so chooses, he/she may dictate an additional note.</p>
Summary	<p>The summary of the SOAP note is immediately available. All codes related to diagnosis, orders, supplies, and injections are immediately available for billing. Pre-certification documentation can also be generated immediately.</p>	<p>SUMMARY (Below is an example of the SOAP/Progress note generated)</p> <p>Patient Name: John Doe (19 year old M) Date of Birth: 11/16/1987 Date of Service: 1/4/2007 8:40:00 AM Account Number: 123 Attending Physician: Jane Doe, M.D. Referring Physician:</p> <p>Subjective: John Doe presents for an initial evaluation of his right shoulder. The patient hurt his shoulder while playing baseball. His shoulder hurts especially during the throwing motion. Review of Systems: Neurological problems include headaches and he smokes.</p> <p>Objective: He is a well-nourished 19 year old male. His height is 6' 2" and weight is 232 pounds. The right shoulder shows the following: Rotator Cuff is strong on Abduction and Forward Flexion. Rotator Cuff is weak on External Rotation with moderate pain and weak on Internal Rotation with severe pain.</p> <p>Assessment: Ordered X-ray for RT Shoulder 1 view. X-rays of Right Shoulder shows no fracture/dislocation or bone abnormalities. Supplies used: ARM SLING (RT). Diagnosis is LOOSE BODY, SHOULDER, TENDONITIS ROTATOR CUFF and SPRAIN/STRAIN ROTATOR CUFF.</p> <p>Plan: Prescribed the following medications: Mobic 15 mg. Follow-up in 2 Week(s). X-ray on return visit. Will discuss possible surgery with patient on return visit.</p>

LOGS

Logs are created on the fly while using the SOAP application. Logs are view only and are used for quick reference. The following logs are available: Prescribed Medications, Injections, Surgeries, Diagnostic Tests, X-Rays, Labs, Physical Therapy, Work Status, and a doctor Synopsis (Site/Diagnosis).

These logs have proven extremely valuable to nurses and staff members when patients return or call back.
